The legal basis on which we use your personal data is consent.

We do not disclose your data to any third party organisations.

Special category (sensitive) data

We do not collect sensitive data, however if you disclose this to us during your enquiry we will not share it with others when processing your request, unless you give your consent to this.

Data retention

The data on the web form is sent to a secure email address (lta@uhi.ac.uk). This data is stored only within the email, and not transferred to any other database. These emails will be retained until the completion of your enquiry, or the date of your booking, whichever is the later.



Your rights and preferences

The following rights are rights of data subjects:

- The right to access your personal data
- The right to rectification if the personal data we hold about you is incorrect
- The right to restrict processing of your personal data

The following rights apply only in certain circumstances:
